



Scott VanDuzer

Not many people can say they've broken a Guinness World Record. But Scott VanDuzer, owner of Big Apple Pizza and Pasta in Fort Pierce, has done it – twice. The latest record was set when VanDuzer and his crew of volunteers baked 1,800 pizzas, stretching 1,777 feet, all to benefit the VanDuzer Foundation (which he founded in 2008 to raise money for local families stricken by tragedy). Proud of his charitable work, VanDuzer repeats a quote from Margaret Mead: "Never doubt that a small group of thoughtful, committed citizens can change the world. Indeed, it's the only thing that ever has."
