## Making Strides Against Breast Cancer



**M**aking Strides Against Breast Cancer unites friends and foes, strangers and neighbors, as hundreds of people come together in this annual non-competitive walk to raise funds and awareness to cure breast cancer.

"Making Strides is not a race; it is a celebration of survivorship, an occasion to express hope and a shared goal to end a disease that threatens the lives of so many people we love," says the American Cancer Society Web site.

Since its beginning in 1993, nearly 5 million walkers of all ages have participated, raising more than \$340 million across the country.

"It's very amazing to see all of these men and women all together joining hands – friends, strangers, neighbors," says Kristi Walker, Martin County's event chair. All the attending survivors are asked to signal the beginning of the race by holding hands on the start line.

This year's event will be held at Memorial Park in downtown Stuart on Oct. 17.
